Short description of the problem that would be addressed by the project:

The project would focus on predicting and understanding gym membership numbers. The aim of the project would be to develop a proof of concept model that given a range of facility attributes, catchment area characteristics and levels of competition could be used to;

- Predict membership numbers.
- Understand the key drivers of gym membership
- Explain the difference in observed membership numbers between gyms
- Explore the impact of changes in facility attributes, catchment area characteristics and levels of competition on membership number

Short description of the data sources that would be used in the project, and how they would be used

The project would principally use the following three data sources:

- Active Places (https://www.activeplacespower.com/). Active Places provides a database of gym and leisure facilities for England and would be used to provide data on facility attributes and competition
- ONS and Census data. ONS and Census data would be used to provide data relating to catchment area characteristics of facilities
- GLL Membership Database the GLL membership database will be used to provide data on membership numbers and usage at each GLL facility

A range of other secondary date sources relating to facilities, catchment areas and competition may also be used.
