Provisional title for project:

Utilising future housing data to model future store requirements

Short description of the problem that would be addressed by the project:

This project will look at how new housing developments impact the local retail environment across England and Wales and how this can be used to model future store requirements for future housing developments. This project will focus on understanding the characteristics and growth of new retail centres around new housing developments over the last 10 years to see if common trends can be determined on best practices, key retail categories and target retailers or subcategories who are key to the success of these locations.

Short description of the data sources that would be used in the project, and how they would be used

LDC Points of Interest (POI) data- over 1.5 million records of all GB retail and leisure units since 2010
Future housing needs assessment – data that looks at the number of houses expected to be delivered across various Local Authority areas over the next 4 years

Would any work by the student need to be carried out on site at the Company (with the exception of supervisory Meetings)?

Student expected to work remotely, with online and in person sessions where needed

Any issues of data confidentiality and IPR that would need to be resolved
